ISCHUA VALLEY FALLING LEAVES REGATTA  
SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 9  
HINSDALE AMERICAN LEGION

End your "Summer of 2017" by participating in the 11th annual Ischua Valley Falling Leaves Regatta, an amateur dice run regatta. Any form of motor-less craft can be entered for a fun trip down the beautiful Ischua Creek. Proceeds benefit the Hinsdale American Legion, Hinsdale Volunteer Fire Department, and the Ischua Vol. Fire Department. Camping is offered all weekend! Camping and boating registration begins at 3pm on Friday; boats and entrants will be transported and in the water by 11am on Saturday. Participants will put-in at the Ischua Creek from Mill Street in Ischua and float to the finish behind the Hinsdale American Legion (approx. 7.8 miles.)

The Ischua Creek is classified as one of the few Class A trout streams by the New York State Dept. of Environmental Conservation. The stream is home to native trout, ospreys, herons, and the American Bald Eagle. You are equally likely to see deer, bear, otter, beaver and other aquatic animals during your venture. This year's regatta is offering a shorter route (5.1 miles), starting at Farwell Road with the same end location.
